Please accept my personal thanks and the thanks of Clancy & Theys for your assistance in helping us and the Orlando International Airport quickly recover from the damage suffered from Hurricane Charley. Your assistance has also been noticed by Orlando International and the Greater Orlando Aviation Authority as well. Hopefully Central Florida and OIA will be spared significant damage by Hurricane Frances, but we are beginning to prepare for damage that may result from the potential path of Hurricane Frances through Central Florida. As a part of that preparation, we may have the need to call upon you again for assistance.

While we recognize that a subcontract has not been put in place, it is important to note that there is a contract in place between GOAA and Clancy & Theys Construction Company for Continuing Vertical Construction Services at OIA and the repair work will fall under that contract.
